

# Summer Camp Counsellors (2 Positions Available)

## Job Summary

Camp Counsellors assist the Camp Lead and Camp Manager in delivering daily art activities and supervising campers. Counsellors help create a positive and supportive environment where children can explore creativity and develop artistic skills.

## Responsibilities

Camp Counsellors will:

- Assist the Camp Lead in developing and implementing **art and play activities**
- Support children while they complete art projects and learn new techniques
- Supervise children during **art activities, outdoor play, and group games**
- Ensure campers follow safety guidelines and house rules
- Monitor children during lunch and snack breaks
- Activity setup and cleanup of studios and outdoor areas
- Maintain a safe and organized workspace
- Monitor supply inventory and inform staff when materials are low (assist with restock)
- Report any concerns or behavioral issues to the Camp Lead
- Interact positively with children, parents/guardians, and staff
- Help organize and display **weekly exhibitions of camper artwork**
- Follow all responsibilities outlined in the **FCAG Code of Conduct**

## Qualifications

Applicants must:

- Be **between 15 and 30 years of age** (Canada Summer Jobs requirement)
- Be a **Canadian Citizen, Permanent Resident, or person with refugee protection status** under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act
- Be legally entitled to work in Canada
- Be available to work **in person for the full 8-week program**
- Have experience working with children ages **5–12**
- Demonstrate reliability, teamwork, and strong communication skills
- Have an interest in **art and creative activities**
- Be able to work independently and collaboratively
- Hold or obtain **HIGH FIVE Principles of Healthy Child Development** before the start date
- Hold or obtain **Standard First Aid certification** before the start date
- Provide a **Vulnerable Sector Screening / Criminal Reference Check** (if over 18)
- **Knowledge of French is considered an asset but is not required.**

# Training Requirements

*Successful candidates will be required to complete the following workplace training in accordance with Ontario regulations. Training may be completed online during staff onboarding if it has not already been completed.*
